
Cache Creek Technical Advisory Committee

Purpose: The Cache Creek Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is a three-member panel of riparian experts who review and make recommendations on proposals for work within the active stream channel, generally between the Capay Dam and Interstate 5. The TAC also collects and analyzes data, identifies maintenance needs and priorities for the creek, and work with a variety of local stakeholders in making recommendations regarding management of the riparian area. These activities are described in the Cache Creek Status Report, which is presented annually to the Board of Supervisors.
