Free Tree Recycling at Landfill & Esparto Recycling & Transfer Station and Holiday Closures

(Woodland, CA) – Free recycling of holiday trees (treecycling) is being offered to Yolo County residents at the Yolo County Central Landfill and the Esparto Recycling & Transfer Station from December 26 through January 15.

Trees are biodegradable and will eventually decompose to provide essential organic matter. Treecycling turns holiday trees into valuable renewable and recyclable resources. Trees to be recycled should be free of all ornaments, flocking, tinsel, garland and lights. There is a limit of two trees per resident for free recycling.

While recycling your tree, please remember that old electronics, such as computers, TVs and monitors, and paper, plastics, cans and bottles can also be recycled every day of operation at the Yolo County Central Landfill and the Esparto Recycling & Transfer Station.

The Yolo County Central Landfill, located at 44090 County Road 28H in Woodland is closed on Christmas and New Year's days. Normal operating hours of the landfill are Mondays through Saturdays, 6:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Sundays, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The Esparto Recycling & Transfer Station, located at 27075 County Road 19A in Esparto is open on Wednesdays and Saturdays, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
