



The Yolo County Central Landfill is now offering lumber that has been salvaged as part of our construction and demolition recycling facility! Come get rid of your trash and leave with some lumber that you can build something with! We have lots of different sizes, shapes and species and our selection is changing constantly! Some lumber is new and unused, some might have nails in it and some may be short cut-offs. Right now we have some great redwood cut-offs that are maybe 2' long, perfect for making planter boxes. We also have some crown and baseboards. they are a little weathered but with a little sanding they can be paint grade. We also have 2x4's, 2x12's, 3x6's 8x8's and everything in between. We even have some short cutoffs that would be great for wood turning blocks! Check out the photo of the hunks of redwood! Maybe build a chicken coop, tree house, shed, you name it, our wood is ideal!

All of this lumber is being offered at a extremely low introductory rate. The price varies by the amount you take. The equivalent of a 60 gallon garbage can worth is only \$3! Fill your car for \$5, mini pick-up for \$10 and full sized pick-up for \$14!

The landfill is located at 44090 County Road 28H, Woodland and is open Monday through Saturday, 6:30 am to 4 pm and Sunday 8 am to 4 pm.
