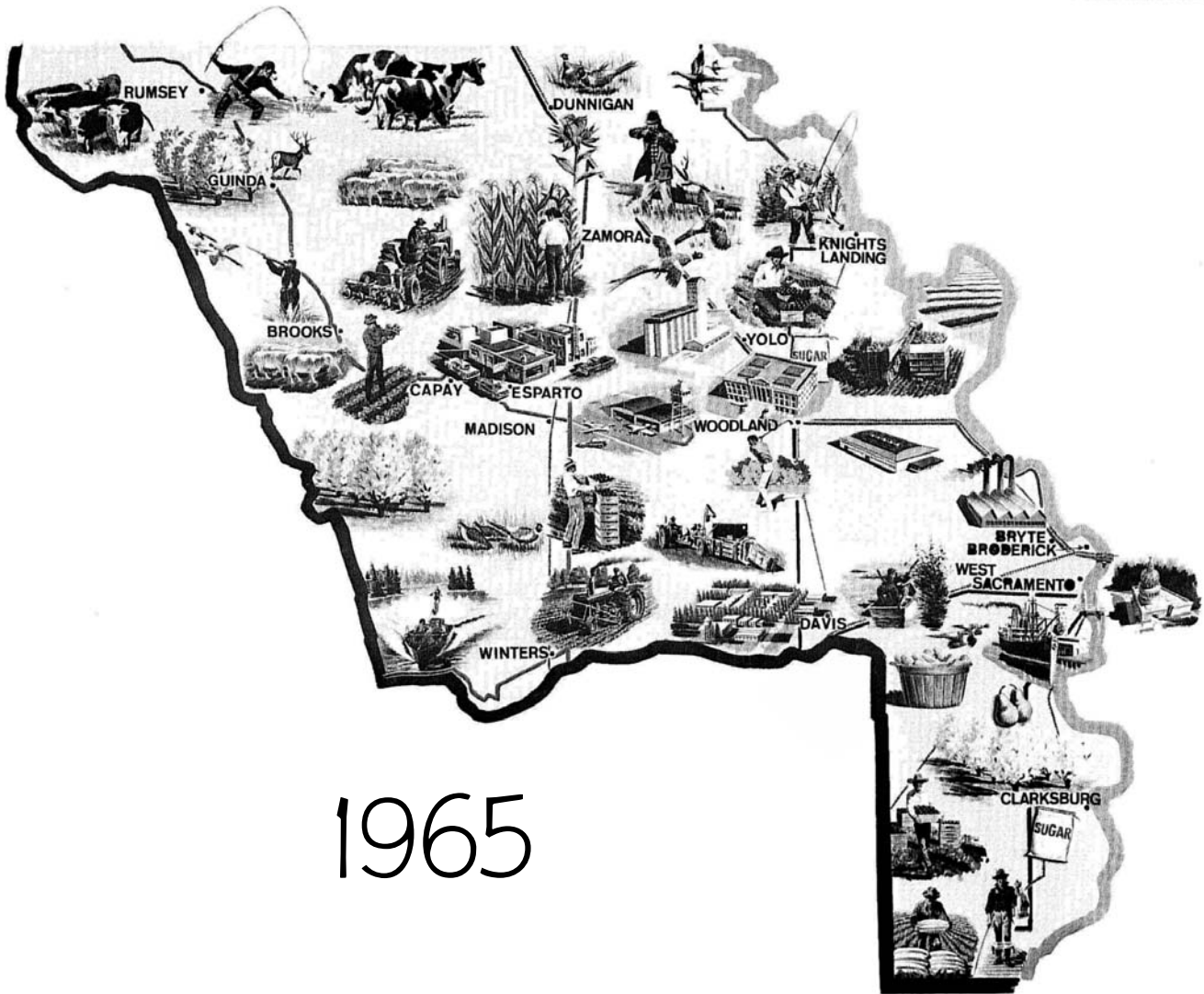

I am pleased to present the 1965 Yolo County Agricultural Crop Report in accordance with Section 65.5 of the California Agricultural Code.

The gross value of production of \$99,160,880 is the largest in the history of the county. Yolo County can proudly boast of eighteen crops, each with a million dollars or more in gross value.

The enclosed statistics are gross returns and should not be mistaken as representing a measure of profit to the producer. Weather conditions during the harvesting of most of our major crops was ideal with the exception of an unusually severe north wind during October which caused considerable damage to many crops.

I wish to express my sincere appreciation to George Dahl, under whose direction this report was compiled, and to the farmers, producers and other organizations who supplied the necessary data and gave so generously of their time and efforts in making this report possible.
