Who must be included in the CalFresh household: Everyone who Purchases and Prepares their meals together (they do not need to be related), Married couples, Children under the age of 22 years old and living with their parents.

Proof needed to get MORE CalFresh benefits:

Shelter Costs: Rent or Mortgage etc.

Utility: Heating or Cooling expenses, Telephone

Dependent Care: Expenses necessary for a Household to accept, keep or seek employment, attend school/training.

Child Support: Proof of child support paid by a person in the household

Qualified medical expenses for individuals that are elderly and/or disabled:

- Costs of medical and dental care, Co-Payments for prescriptions or appointments, Dentures, Hearing Aids, Batteries, Incontinence supplies, Medicare premiums, Special telephone equipment for persons with a disability, Prescription eyeglasses, Contact lenses, Acupuncture, Chiropractic or Herbal treatments, etc.

Some verifications that must be provided:

Must be a **Yolo County resident** to apply in Yolo County

Social Security numbers for all applicants

Proof of Identity: Photo ID, Passport, Birth Certificate etc.

Proof of all income: current pay stubs, child support, alimony, Social Security benefits, Unemployment benefits, VA benefits, State disability benefits, etc.

Non-Citizens: Proof of legal status in the US such as Permanent Resident card

These are examples of the minimum verifications required. Customers may be asked to provide additional verifications.

Who is not eligible to CalFresh?

Undocumented individuals: Individuals who do not meet citizenship requirements

Fleeing Felons and/or Probation Violators: Individuals fleeing from the law

Ineligible Students: Individuals enrolled in an institution of higher learning who fail because they do not meet the work requirements or do not have an exemption to the student eligibility rules.

How long does it take to get CalFresh?

It can take up to 30 days from the date of the application to have a determination made on the CalFresh eligibility. Applicants must be interviewed, and this can be done via telephone or face to face.

How do you get an EBT card?

Once you are approved for CalFresh benefits, you can pick up an EBT card in one of the 4 offices in Yolo County, or a card can be mailed to you.

When will you get your CalFresh benefits monthly?

The last digit of your case number determines the date you will get your benefits monthly. Example: Last digit is a (9), you will get your benefits on the 9th of the month as long as you continue to be eligible.
