

SUBJECT: Combination of Youth Council and School-to-Career Committee

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt **Resolution No. _____** consolidating the functions of the Yolo County Youth Council and the School-to-Career Committee.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION

Required membership of the Youth Council is nearly identical to the School-to-Career Committee. Consolidating these two advisory functions would allow for the development of a comprehensive system of youth services that includes representatives from all types of agencies which provide youth services.

BACKGROUND

Under the direction of the Workforce Investment Board, staff has developed the attached resolution. Research has been done to ensure that all required membership is represented on the Yolo County Workforce Investment Board Youth Council.

The School-to-Career Committee has served as an advisory council for School-to-Career programs which are administered by the Yolo County Office of Education. The Workforce Investment Board Youth Council was established by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors on March 28, 2000. It was discovered that the membership of the two committees was nearly identical. Discussions with School-to-Career Coordinator revealed that the School-to-Career Committee would benefit from an expanded membership that would include all Youth Council members required under the Workforce Investment Act.

The attached resolution was developed to ensure that the Youth Council would have all required members and would have balanced representation of the various sectors of youth services.

BUDGET

Staff support will be paid by Federal funding. No County funds will be used.

AGENCY COORDINATION

This issue has been discussed among appointed members of the Youth Council, members of the School-to-Career Committee, staff of Yolo County Department of Employment and Social Services and the Yolo County Office of Education.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF YOLO COUNTY CONSOLIDATING THE FUNCTIONS OF THE
YOLO COUNTY YOUTH COUNCIL AND SCHOOL-TO-CAREER COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors has established a Youth Council as the subcommittee of the Workforce Investment Board; and

WHEREAS, the duties, membership and authority of the Youth Council are outlined in Resolution 00-53; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to make the Youth Council the most effective and efficient council that will develop a comprehensive system of Youth Services in Yolo County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

The functions of the Youth Council will be consolidated with the School to Career Action Committee as follows:

1. **Members**

There will be two categories of voting members of the Youth Council:

- a. Voting members of the Workforce Investment Board; and
- b. Others appointed by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors as outlined in Resolution 00-53; and

School to Career Committee members who are not appointed to the Youth Council by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors will not be voting members but may attend meetings to provide input on Youth Issues.

2. **Meetings**

Youth Council meetings will take place at the same time and location as regularly scheduled meetings of the School to Career Committee. Schedule, Agenda and Minutes of the Youth Council meeting will be kept separate from items which are strictly School to Career and will be made available to the public according to the Brown Act.

Meetings will be held on a monthly basis throughout the school year. The WIB chairman and the Yolo County Board of Supervisors reserve the right to call additional meetings if necessary.

3. **Staff**

Staff to the Youth Council will be provided by the Administrative Division of the Yolo County Department of Employment and Social Services. Yolo County Office of Education will continue to provide staff support for School to Career Committee meetings and activities.

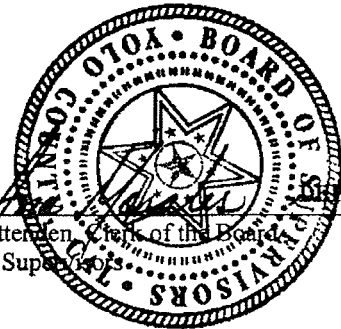
