



Sign Up Today! Upcoming Produce Safety Training Workshops

**Classes are from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm

This course is one way to satisfy the FSMA Produce Safety Rule requirement outlined in § 112.22(c) that requires: At least one supervisor or responsible party for your farm must have successfully completed food safety training at least equivalent to that received under standardized curriculum recognized as adequate by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

This eight hour class will cover the following topics:

- Introduction to Produce Safety
- Worker Health, Hygiene, and Training
- Soil Amendments
- Wildlife, Domesticated Animals, and Land Use
- Agricultural Water
- Postharvest Handling and Sanitation
- How to Develop a Farm Food Safety Plan

In addition to learning about produce safety best practices, key parts of the FSMA Produce Safety Rule requirements will be outlined within each topic.

Who should attend?

Fruit and vegetable growers, Farm Labor Contractors and others interested in learning about produce safety, the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) Produce Safety Rule, Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs), and comanagement of natural resources and food safety.
