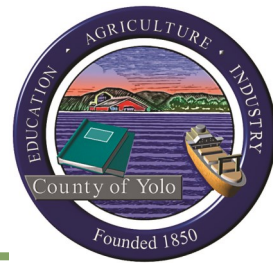

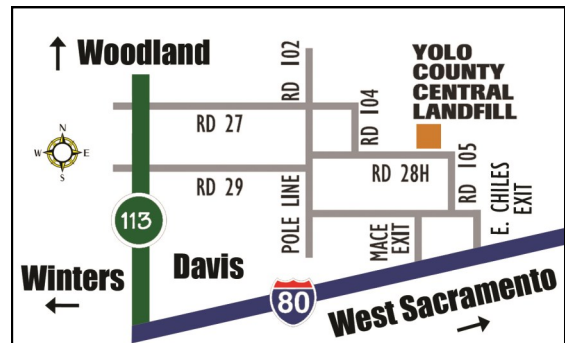

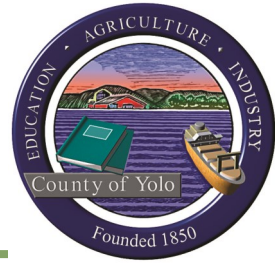
NO Sharps/Needles or Inhalers (aerosols) accepted in green bins. (See HHW days above)

CONDADO DE YOLO PROGRAMA DE RECOLECCIÓN RESIDUOS PELIGROS DEL HOGAR

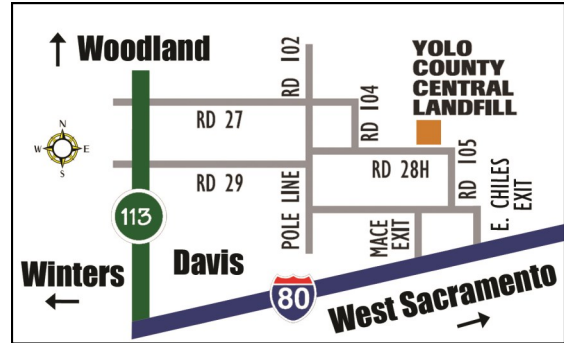
